

Call for proposals from local artisans

The Tsleil-Waututh Child & Family Development Centre has a unique opportunity to strengthen our cultural program. We receive funding to support an initiative which includes 1) Carving Mini-Canoes, and 2) Creating a Language Book.

Each letter must state agreement to the following terms.

- 1) Carving Mini-Canoes: a local artisan must be willing to;
 - Agree to meet with the manager and a delegate as an interview process.
 - Submit an approved Criminal Records Check, Schedule E for Employees or Volunteer at a Licensed Child Care Facility.
 - Spend several hours engaging the children in carving mini canoes to be used in water play.
 - Total project time (preparation, engaging children in activity, completing unfinished work to ensure canoes can be used in water play) will be a minimum of 15 hours.
 - Total contract expenses will amount to no more than \$750.

- 2) Art Work for a language Book, a local artisan must be willing to:
 - Agreement to meet with the manager and his delegate as an interview process.
 - Work cooperatively with the Head Start Coordinator and her delegate to complete project.
 - Total project time to be a minimum of 15 hours.
 - Total contract expenses will amount to no more than \$750
